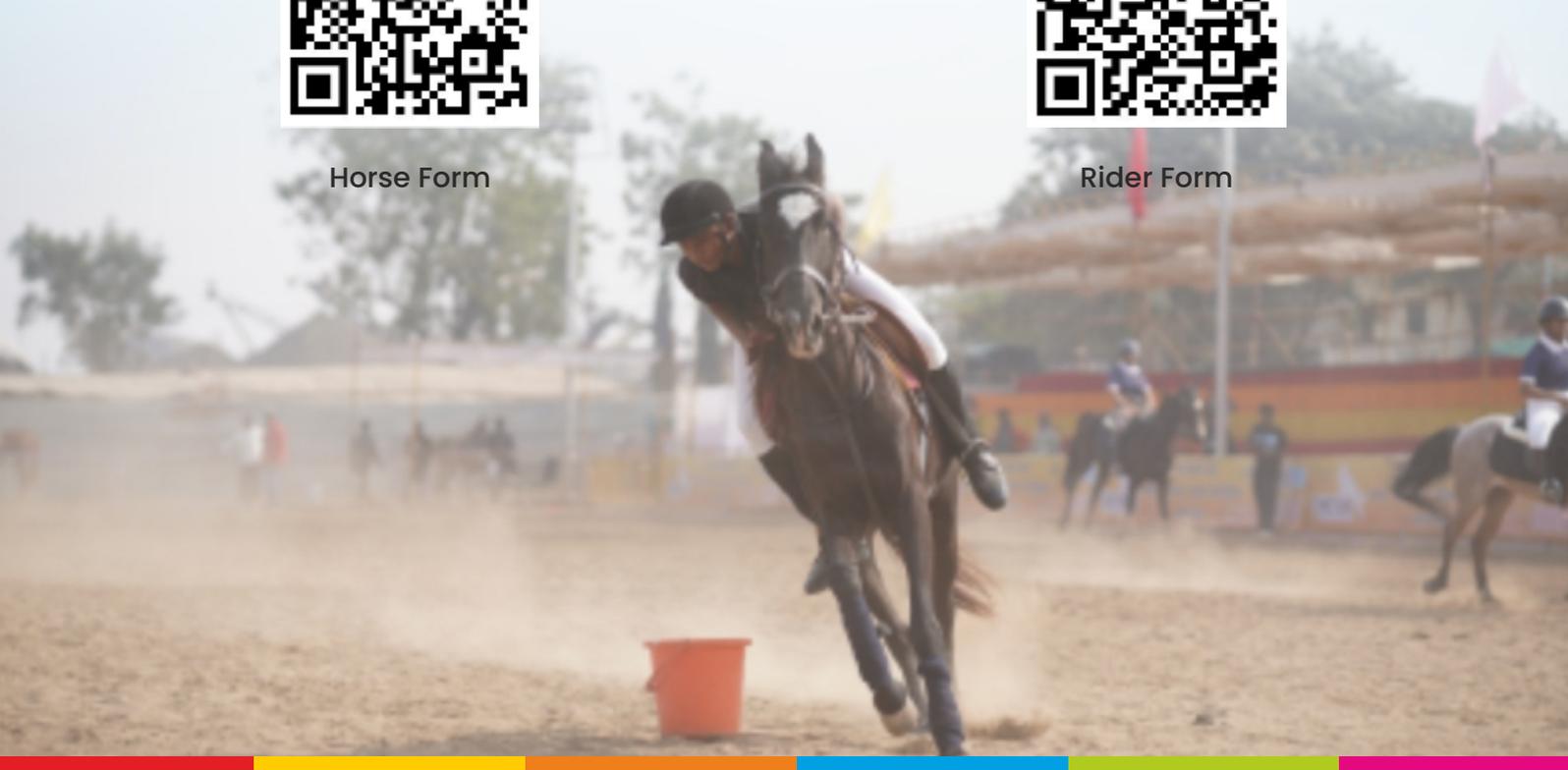

Code Of Conduct

(As laid down by FED)

- 1 In all Equestrian sports, the welfare of the horse must be considered as paramount priority
- 2 The well-being of the horse shall be considered above the demands of breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organizers, sponsors & / or officials.
- 3 All handling and veterinary treatment must ensure the health and welfare of the horses.
- 4 The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.
- 5 Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation of horses to and from the competition venue.
- 6 Emphasis should be on increasing education in training, equestrian sports and on promotion of scientific studies on equine health.
- 7 In the interest of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.
- 8 All riding and training methods must take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the Chetak Equine to be cruel abusive.
- 9 All participating teams should establish adequate control in order to ensure that all persons in their team respect the welfare of the horse.
10. Competition Rules and Regulations shall be reviewed to ensure such welfare

Experience Categories

1. Beginner Category :

There is no age restriction in this category. Any participant who has not won in any equestrian competition before is eligible to participate in this category.

If the participant places in the top 3 positions in any equestrian sporting event, (excluding mounted sports) the participant will mandatorily upgrade to the participants age-appropriate category in the next season.

*Note to captains this category is specially for encouraging new riders of all ages

Please Note:

1. Competitors may upgrade themselves up to a higher category but once upgraded may not return to their original category during that season. Example Beginner to Amateur or Open.
2. All previous points accumulated in the previous category by the rider will lapse when the rider upgrades and the rider will start with a fresh score upon upgrading
3. In case a rider upgrades his/her category, the points accumulated by the rider for the team will not lapse.

4. Riders have the option to reset their category only between seasons.
5. Riders of all ages will be eligible to participate in the Beginner category. But once a Beginner rider wins or gets placed within any event during the season, she/he will need to participate in his/her Chetak Festival appropriate category from the next season.

Example scenario :

Rider A starts Season '18-19 in the Beginner category, but decides to upgrade to Junior category during a show, at which point she will forgo the points accrued competing in the Beginner category up till then.

She will continue to ride in the Junior category for all the shows she participates in for the rest of the season. Rider A has the option to stay in the Junior category or reset back to the

Beginner category, if she chooses, only at the beginning of Season '19-20)

6. The Beginner and Amateur categories can be retained by the rider for the full season.

List of events

- **Dressage :**

Dressage is a French term meaning “training” and its purpose is to develop the horse's natural athletic ability and willingness to work making him calm, supple and attentive to his/her rider. In this event the rider and horse have to perform a pre-set test, each step of the test is given points from 0 to 10 by the judges. Zero being not executed, & 10 being excellent. The rider with the highest score WINS.

- **Ball and Bucket Race**

In this event the participants will be distributed in random groups of 5 to 6 riders. Then the groups compete internally and then the first finisher. In the next round riders compete against each other to get the winning positions. The game would be to put the ball which will be given to each rider in the bucket placed on the other side of the arena. The rider who puts the ball first in the bucket and reaches the finish line back wins. Canter is allowed.

Note: No stallions allowed in this event.

- **Pole Bending**

In pole bending, the rider will be man overing through the line of the poles which are kept at a pre-set distance. At the last pole, the rider must take a "U" turn and repeat the course. In case the rider misses a pole, he/she must get back to the missed and negotiate the course accordingly. Knocking down a pole incurs a 2 second time penalty, thus adding to the total time taken to complete the course. Canter is allowed.

- **Show jumping top score :**

Horse and rider have 60 seconds to cross obstacles set up in the jumping area. Each obstacle has a certain score. (jump no 01 for 10 points, jump no 02 for 20 and so on till jump no 10 for 100 points) Upon successfully crossing the obstacle the point value is added to the rider's total score. Each obstacle may be jumped twice only from either side of the jump. There is one jump known as the joker. Successfully jumping the joker is worth 200 points. In case of a fault while attempting the joker 200 points are deducted.

- **Show lumping Normal :**

In this event there is a pre-set route that the rider and horse must follow. Refusing a jump or dropping it results in penalty points being given. The rider with the least penalties is considered to be the winner. In case more than one rider completes the course without incurring any penalties, or in the event of a tie, riders will take part in a jump off. In a jump off riders attempt to complete the course and the time taken to complete the course is considered. In case of equal scores, the fastest time wins.

- **Hat Race :**

Competitors ride towards the other end of the arena where they must put their hat on top of the empty pole provided. There will be fewer poles than riders. Failure to put the hat on a pole will

result in elimination. In case the hat drops on the ground then the rider has to dismount, collect the hat and mount the horse again.
